Nice to meet you, and thank you for taking the time to listen to me and my case. There's a lot to unpack here, so I'll try to keep it as organized as I can.

First, you may have already done this, but I did a quick Google search and Rick Rynearson (a.k.a. Richard Lee) has a history of being uncooperative and confrontational with law enforcement and he is a serial internet troller.

Dude, I'm rather insulted at your knee-jerk post, especially since you've been following my posts so closely that you KNOW that I've been making this point - not just with Facebook posts - but publicly for a long time, approaching 17 years here beginning with my work on the Bainbridge Island Japanese American Exclusion Memorial.

You weren't here on March 30, 2002, but at our first commemoration ceremony 15 years ago at the site, I invited a broad representation of faiths to participate at that event, including a muslim cleric from Seattle. As the emcee, I stated at that event that I feared for my muslim and Arab American friends after the September 11, 2001 attacks, which was still raw since it had just happened five months earlier.

I don't have to go back 15 years to explain or defend my strong public stance on standing up against discrimination and hate crimes. Let me refresh your memory of some posts in the last few weeks:

From December 6, 2016:

"Clarence Moriwaki, President, Bainbridge Island Japanese American Community (BIJAC)

My birthday was November 8th, and it was a wonderful day for me until 11 p.m. or so, when my birthday/election night watching party came to an abrupt halt. We sat in stunned silence when it became clear that Donald Trump would likely win the electoral college.

The following day, my two adopted Bainbridge Island moms—96 and 83 years old—treated me to a birthday lunch. We talked it out and eventually realized that this election season with its bewildering bigotry, prejudice, hatred, and vulgarity unearthed her deeply buried feelings of fear, loss, and uncertainty that she felt 75 years ago, when she and my other adopted mom were forcibly removed from Bainbridge Island during WWII.

The next day the issue of how to respond to the growing reports of post-election hate crimes was placed on the agenda at our monthly board meeting of the Bainbridge Island Japanese American Exclusion Memorial Association.

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With unanimous support, the board voted to make a strong statement of our opposition to hate crimes and a call for sanity and safety in the form of an Open Letter. I was tasked to write the letter, which was completed before noon on Veterans Day."

And, of course, that Open Letter that I wrote three days after the election, which was signed and unanimously endorsed by the [City of Bainbridge Island](#), [Washington](#) and more than 450 elected officials, groups, business, civic and community leaders and citizens.

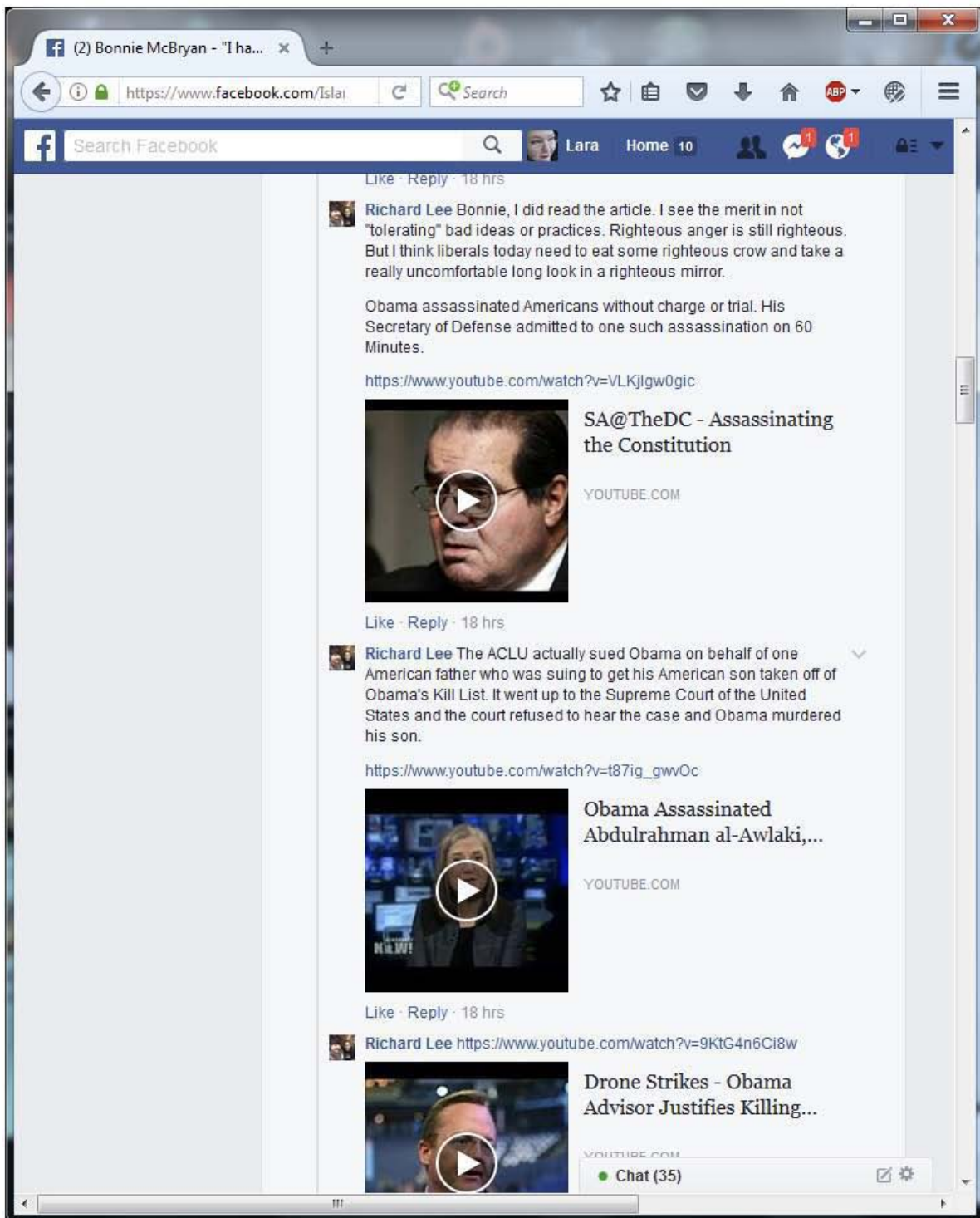

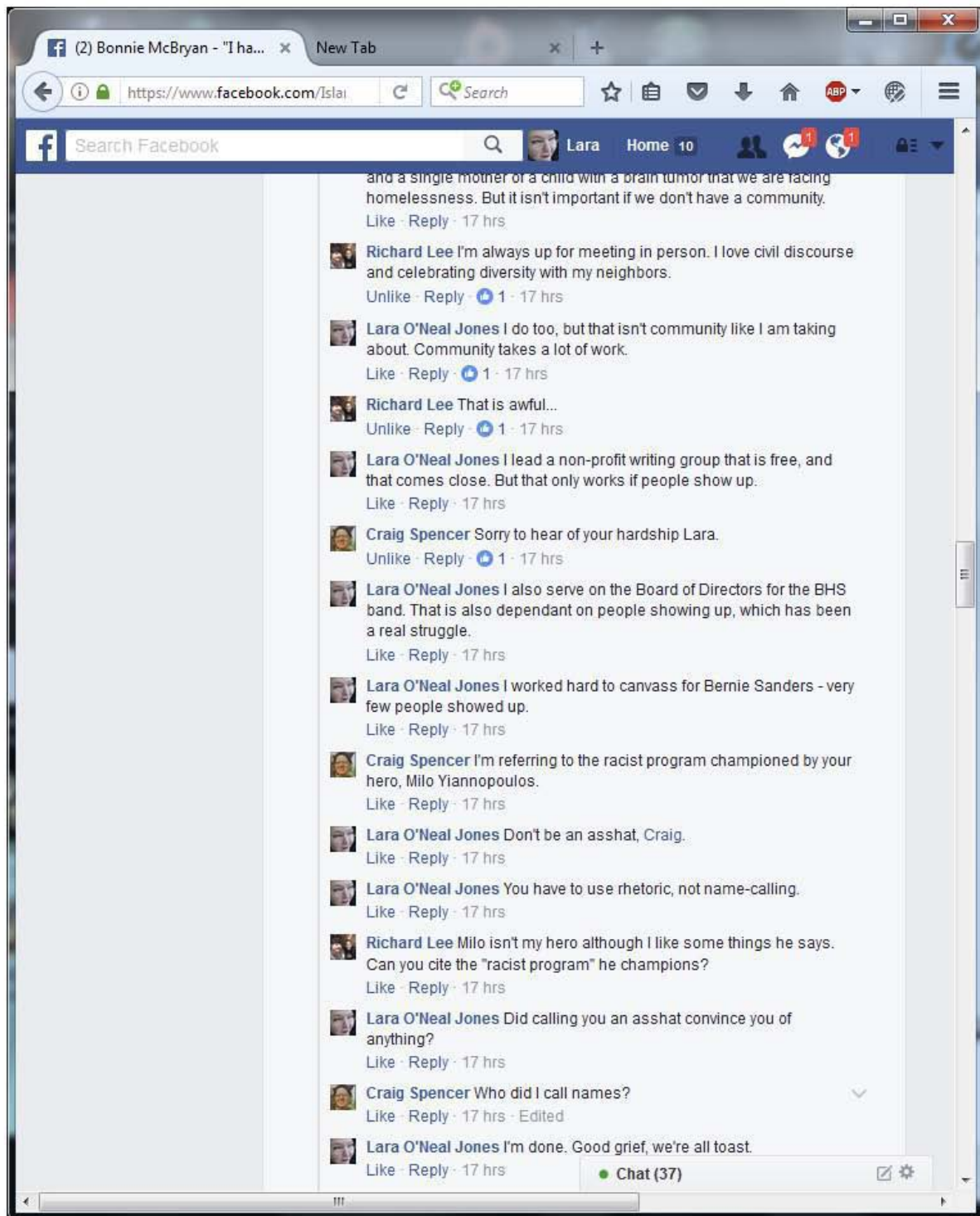

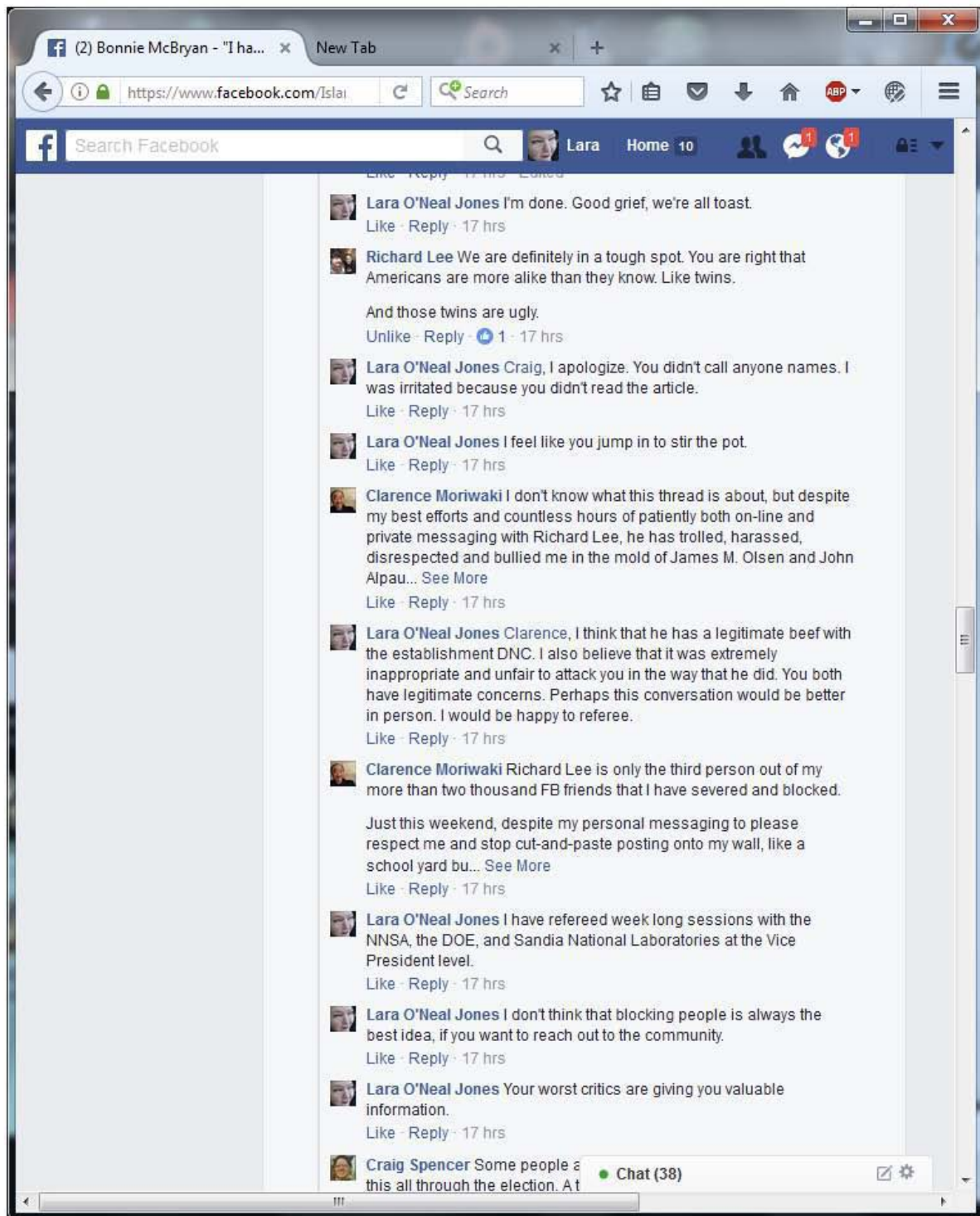

So, my Facebook page is like me hosting a party. 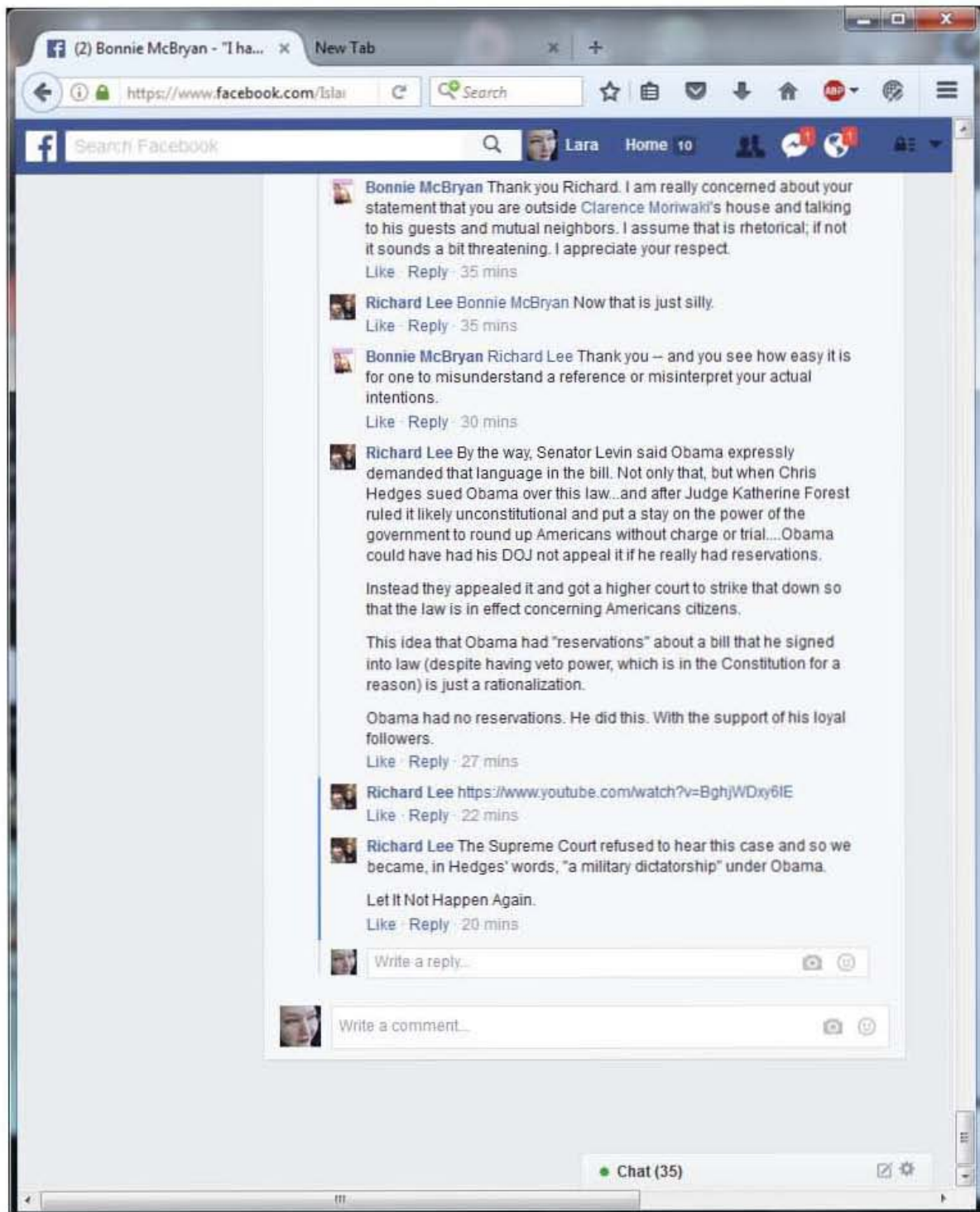

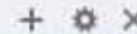



Hi Mr Moriwaki,

I have been receiving your emails. I compiled what you have sent me and forwarded the case to the prosecutor to review for charges. It will be up to the prosecutor to determine in criminal charges should be brought at this point. Either way, I would suggest applying for a protection order from the Bainbridge Island Muni Court. Like we discussed before, if an order was granted from the court, the order would prevent Mr. Ryneerson from being able to continue bothering you and would actually criminalize certain behaviors, depending on which behaviors the court finds reasonable to criminalize for Mr. Ryneerson. That is to say, Mr Ryneerson could potentially be arrested and taken to jail if he violations the order.

Anyway, the case is complete unless for whatever reason the prosecutor forwards it back to me for follow-up. You should be able to request a copy of the report online at the city website, or in person at our office through what is called a public records request. Making the request just starts the process of us creating a copy to be issued to you. It's very common, especially in cases where there is as many attachments as yours, that you will not get the copy the same day that you request it, but you will get one.

Hopefully I was of some help to you on this case.

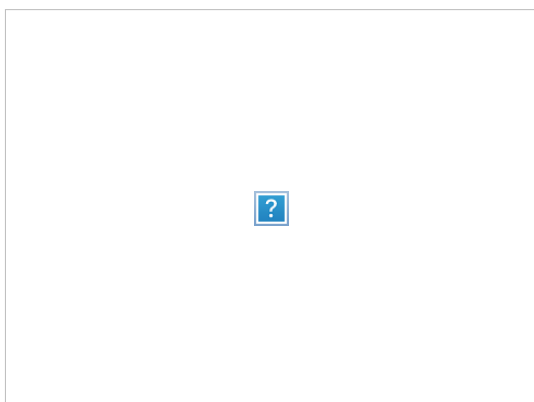





While I am told that he has removed some of these posts, that is not enough.

As you can see from the attached screen shots, Ryneerson/Lee never does disavow, counter nor discourage any of the comments or attacks against me nor the judge, which including threats to kill us. Indeed, he actually “likes” many of them.

You may go see these pages for yourself. I am told by my friends that Ryneerson has never disavowed nor discouraged any of these comments of violence and murder, let alone just simply having the common decency to state that he will not allow such threatening statements to be allowed.

Ryneerson’s silence is demonstrable complicity that endorses these threats.

I am not over reacting. Ryneerson/Lee is deliberately and demonstrably attracting irrational, angry people who believe him wholeheartedly, some of whom are willing to publicly state actions of violence.
