SOURCE OF ACTIVITY:

While on uniformed patrol on 12/16/18 at approximately 0902 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to a burglary that occurred at 155 Madison Ave N, the apartment belonging to Clarence Moriwaki.

INVESTIGATION:

At 0911 hours I contacted Moriwaki at his apartment. He said that someone had moved things around in his home. Moriwaki showed me how his alarm clock was turned upside down, and his wrist watch on his nightstand was face down. Moriwaki says he is a very orderly person and is particular about how things are placed in his home. Moriwaki said that the pillows piled up in the corner of his room aren't stacked properly, and that everything that is typically stacked behind his bedside organizer were knocked on the ground. The organizer appeared to have been pushed, knocking over the items stacked behind it. Moriwaki showed me that in his bathroom, someone had made a mess with his toothpaste, taken apart his soap dispenser, turned a cup upside down, and moved around his pill bottles. Mirowaki said he already cleaned it up, but that his clothes were in a pile on the ground next to his bed, which is not something he would have done, and that his wallet was still in his pants pocket, which again is something he would not have done. Mirowaki said that his phone was also not plugged in charging when he woke up, and that he always plugs his phone in before bed. Mirowaki said he called 911 approximately five minutes after waking up. Mirowaki said he also found two small stains on his bed cover, and two more in his living room.

Mirowaki said that he arrived home at approximately 2200 hours last night, 12/15/16. Mirowaki said he definitely would have noticed if any of these things were out of place in the manner described. Mirowaki said that he was exhausted when he got home last night. Mirowaki said he had come from the Harbor Public House on Parfitt Way. He said he was out with friends and had drank a little. Mirowaki said that he remembers coming home exhausted, brushing his teeth and peeing, then getting in bed, but does not remember anything else. Mirowaki said that no one else should have been in his home. Mirowaki said the disorder must have been made after he fell asleep.

The two stains in Mirowaki's living room appear to be from where someone sneezed and got snot on the walls. The stains on Mirowaki's bed spread look to be blood stains approximately 1cm² in total area. The stains were all Photographed.

Mirowaki could find nothing damaged, and said that nothing appeared to have been stolen.

Mirowaki said that someone must have broken in just to mess things up to screw with his head.

Mirowaki said he does not sleepwalk.

I took latent print from the items that had been moved as well of photographs of the prints in their locations. I instructed Mirowaki to come to the Bainbridge Island police station during the week to provide elimination prints.

On 03/02/19 I received a phone call from Moriwaki. He wanted to report that he had identified the person who had broken into his home. Moriwaki started by saying that the same day I investigated the break in, he went to eat some cheese in his kitchen, but could not find his cheese slicer. Moriwaki said that he was not above using knife to slice his cheese, so the missing slicer did not phase him too much at that time. Moriwaki then said that the next morning, he found the slicer in one of his pots. He again said that it did not phase him at the time. Moriwaki said he did not tell anyone about this, except for friends of his. Moriwaki said that recently, Rynearson had commented on one of Moriwaki's posts, mentioning something about misplaced silverware. Moriwaki said that the only possible way for Rynearson to know anything about the silverware would be for him to have been the one to have broken in. I attempted to contact Rynearson but was unable to speak with him.

I have placed the copy of the facebook comment in the bin to be attached to the report.

Officer Norton,

Thank you for our chat on March 1, 2019.

The tweet in the email message that I sent to you after our conversation attached below by Richard Lee Rynearson is clear self-incrimination that he, or someone that he hired or knows, broke into my home.

There is no way Richard Lee Rynearson would know about anything about anything being moved in my kitchen.

I didn't know that anything had been moved around in my kitchen until four days after the break-in and I never reported it to COBI PD, so there is no public record of which he could have learned about this transgression.

As you know, the break-in into my home took place sometime in the late evening, Saturday, Dec. 15 and/or in the early morning of Sunday Dec. 16, 2018.

With my long-anticipated holiday trip to Mexico to begin just days after this disturbing break-in on Thursday, Dec. 20th, looking forward to my upcoming departure helped keep me sane, hoping that the change of scenery, being with friends and getting miles away from Bainbridge Island would help me forget about all of this.

During the eve of my departure, on Wednesday evening, Dec. 19th I was going to have some cheese, crackers and wine as I packed my roll-on, but I could not find my cheese slicer.

I was confused because I always leave it with the other utensils in the drawer to the left of the stove. I just simply used a knife to cut the cheese, enjoyed it with the crackers and wine as I packed my suitcase and then went to bed.

I got up the next morning and was going to make my usual oatmeal breakfast. I pulled out the small saucepan from the cabinet to the right of the stove, and at the bottom of the saucepan under the glass lid was my cheese slicer.

I looked around the kitchen to see if anything else was moved, and yes, some spoons were on the lower shelf with the larger pots and pans. The cutlery is in the far top drawer on the other end and opposite side of the kitchen.

I thought for a moment about calling COBI PD, but I was busy making breakfast and getting ready to leave for the ferry, plus I thought there was already plenty of evidence of someone being in my home and garage.

I also simply didn't want to think about this disturbing incident and have it ruin the outlook and joy of my trip, so I just got busy getting myself ready, going to the ferry, riding the train to the airport and finally departing.

Since I didn't report it, there is no public record of anything happening in my kitchen. Only a handful of very close friends confidentially know about the kitchen incident.

Rynearson's incriminating tweet shook me when I first saw it, and that's why I immediately called you.

However, even more glaring evidence of incrimination is what Rynearson has NOT done.

Richard Lee Rynearson is a compulsive troll and sociopath who will attack, belittle and mock anyone and everyone for the slightest transgression, hoping to elicit a reaction.

Once he snares someone, he's off to the races with a barrage of internet comments, tweets, videos, memes and comments.

He's also a thin skinned psychopath who is in a constant state of victimhood, thus his two-year (and still ongoing) obsession with me when I had the gall and I dared to block him, ignore his attacks and refuse to bend to his demands.

Thus, the very fact that he HAS NOT gone on a 24/7 tweet and facebook storm attacking me for suspecting him of entering my home is totally alien to his method of operation,

Rynearson manufactures claims of wrongdoing and tweets outrage on a daily, sometimes hourly, basis, but finally he has a bona fide reason to be outraged at me for suspecting him of breaking into my home.

Why isn't he aggressively - and legitimately I would add - attacking me for accusing him of a crime, demeaning his reputation and demanding an apology?

Indeed, given his love of going to court, he likely would have filed lawsuits and defamation charges against me.

If someone had suspected or accused me of breaking into their home, I and any other normal person would be outraged, say WTF a lot and demand a retraction, apology, perhaps even file charges, but everyone would want to eliminate the lie and protect their reputation.

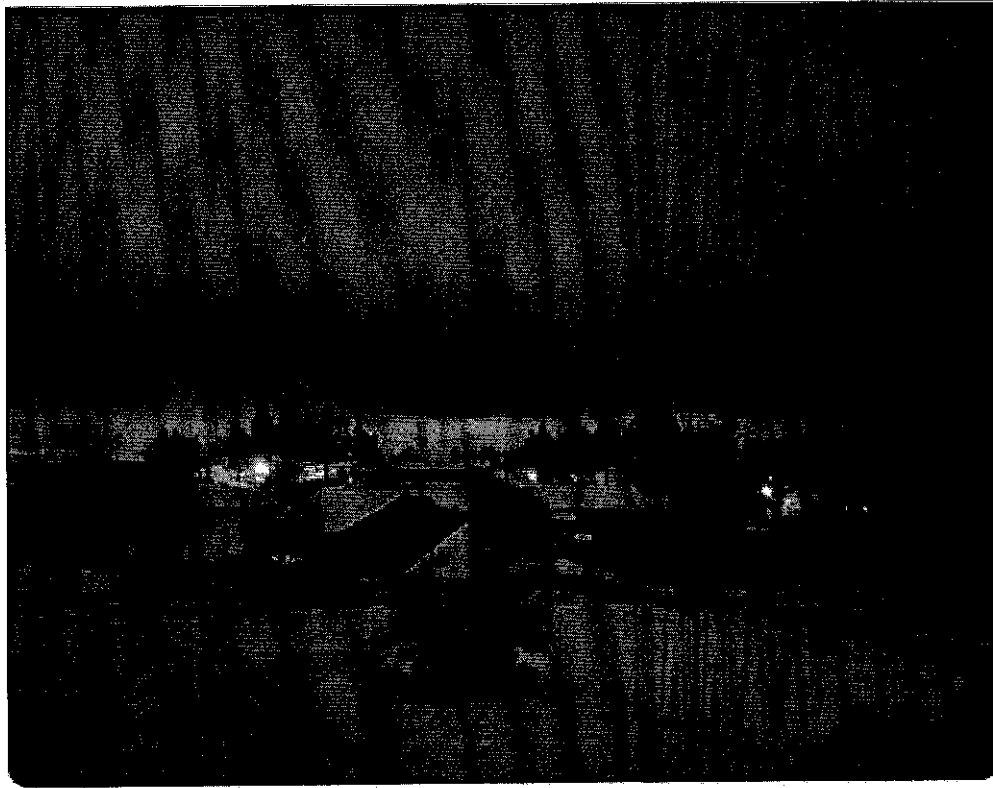

Results and Conclusions

The lift cards contain four impressions suitable for comparison that were marked P-1 though P-4. These impressions are correlated to the respective lifts in the evidence list. Upon further examination, P-4 was voided due to the lack of clear ridge detail.

P-1, P-2, and P-3 were identified as the left ring, right index, and right middle fingers of Clarence Moriwaki (D.O.B. 11/08/55).



Methods and Observations

The eight submitted lift cards were analyzed by the undersigned for latent prints. P-1 through P-4 were compared to the submitted exemplars.

Remarks

Identification is the opinion of an examiner that there is sufficient quality and quantity of detail in agreement to conclude that two impressions originated from the same source.
